## 2. Transfer fees

To send money to Benin, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Comoros, Ivory Coast, DRC, Congo Brazzaville, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Haiti, India, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Morocco, Mauritania, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, Togo, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, Chad, Tunisia, or Vietnam, the rate is:	
<b>€1.99</b> Withdrawal fee not included <b>If you want to transfer between €0.01 and €100</b>	<b>€2.99</b> Withdrawal fee not included <b>If you want to transfer between €100.01 and €950</b>

To send money to Senegal, the rate is:	
<b>€2.49</b> Withdrawal fee <u>included</u> <b>If you want to transfer between €0.01 and €100</b>	<b>€3.79</b> Withdrawal fee <u>included</u> <b>If you want to transfer between €100.01 and €950</b>

To send money to Madagascar, the rate is:	
<b>€0</b> Withdrawal fee not included <b>If you want to transfer between €0.01 and €950</b>	

**Note:** the euro is converted into the currency of the beneficiary's country according to the daily exchange rate offered by the Service and visible to the User at the time of the Transaction. The exchange rate may depend on the Approved Receiving Partner chosen by the Issuer so that the Beneficiary can receive the funds. Currency conversion fees may apply.

With regard to international or domestic transfers, beneficiaries may be charged withdrawal fees, the amount of which will vary depending on the partner concerned by the transaction.

<b>To send money to</b> - Europe – SEPA (France, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Germany, Netherlands, Portugal, Ireland and Luxembourg), the rate is:	
<b>€1.99</b> Withdrawal fee not included <b>If you want to transfer between €0.01 and €100</b>	<b>€2.99</b> Withdrawal fee not included <b>If you want to transfer between €100.01 and €950</b>

Info: you can send money from mainland France to Reunion/Mayotte, Martinique, Guadeloupe, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Germany, Portugal, Luxembourg, Ireland and the Netherlands, and vice versa.
